1. Ortonese Malvasia, Italy

A juicy medium bodied wine with honeyed apricot and peach aromas.

2. Costa Vera Sauvignon Blanc, Chile

A pure fruity sauvignon packed full of grassy tropical fruit. Refreshing with a tangy finish.

3. Ortonese Sangiovese Merlot, Italy

Smooth and soft with hints of spice and berry notes. A fantastic wine with a dry rounded finish.

4. Gladium Tempranillo, Spain

Medium bodied with stacks of red fruit flavours. A hint of warmth & soft tannins result in a pleasant spicy finish.

5. Mont-Auriol Syrah Rosé, Languedoc France

Packed full of crushed raspberry aromas and a delicate acidity. A seriously impressive Rosé, with a clean edge and a dry finish, light in colour and makes the perfect match for a lazy summer lunch.

35. Villa Brunasca Prosecco, Italy

Fresh, light and clean; apple aromas & delicate fizz gives this crisp wine finesse.

36. Il Mionetto Prosecco Rosé, Italy

Delicate bouquet of roses & raspberries. Fun, stylish & highly drinkable!

37. Baguet Jouette NV, Champagne France

£39.50

A small family house in the fifth generation of champagne making, soft and richly flavoured with crisp acidity

38. Camel Valley Cornwall Brut, Cornwall

£39.50

Gold medal fizz that continues to win acclaim and beat top Champagne houses in tastings. Light and fresh, it is reminiscent of pear drops and elderflower. Delicious and elegant, perfect for any celebration.

39. Veuve Clicquot NV, Champagne France

£59.50

Perfect example of the harmony between delicacy and power, a truly exquisite champagne

40. Bollinger Special Cuvee, Champagne France

£74.30

A biscuit scented nose is complimented with hints of white fruit while the rich, full-bodied palate is perfectly balanced by fresh acidity and a soft, subtle mousse

From a small family producer made with care and attention. Subtle with toasty flavours

White wines

- 6. Malassagne Picpoul de Pinet, Languedoc France** £19.70
Clean, crisp lemon notes with a dry zesty finish. A beautiful companion to seafood dishes.
- 7. Vinas Riojanas Torrontes, Argentina** £15.60
Ripe peach aromas, medium dry with a delicious soft rich finish. Great with spicy foods.
- 8. Mont-Auriol Chardonnay, Languedoc France** £17.70
Ripe apple fruit with a hint of vanilla on the nose. Fresh & powerful with a rich acidity
- 9. Chateau le Noë Muscadet Sur Lie, Loire France** £20.90
This Melon de Bourgogne spends added time on the lees giving this wine more body crisp and fresh, with a bracing citrus edge.
- 10. Caldora Trebianno d' Abruzzo, Italy** £16.50
Filled with peach and apple aromas, floral notes and a clean refreshing finish.
- 11. Cofrade Rioja, Spain** £16.90
Young and zesty, this wine delivers clean fruit and a lingering zesty finish. Great with fish dishes.
- 12. Arca Nova Vino Verdhe, Portugal** £19.30
Vinho Verde "Green Wine" is made using the Loureiro and Pedernã varieties, and has a gentle sparkle which tingles on the tongue. It is light and filled with citrus aromas and has a crisp body.
- 13. Naire Verdejo, Spain** £16.95
Intense nose with fruit aromas, such as pineapple, banana, lemon and grapefruit. Citrus fruit hints and a pleasant, bitter finish. The perfect accompaniment to white fish dishes, seafood and rice dishes..
- 14. The Crossings Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough New Zealand** £23.50
Processed in stainless steel to retain all the fresh dry acidity that characterises this variety. Aromas of passion fruit fill the nose, with melon and stone fruit flavours balancing the fresh and clean finish.
- 15. Camel Valley Bacchus, Cornwall** £27.40
Bacchus, a modern variety, is a cross of Sylvaner and Riesling, giving a dry wine, with amazing aromas and touches of elderflower. Often called England's answer to Sancerre, it is fresh and clean with distinctive fruit, a real taste of Cornwall!
- 16. Lagar de Bouza Albarinio, Spain** £28.60
Full and round, this wine uses more of the pressed juice to give power and complex flavours. A crisp, lemony style of wine with character and balance.
- 17. Domaine des Clarineaux Sancerre, Loire France** £34.70
A delicious stylish balanced Sancerre with pear notes, apple and gooseberry fruit. Zesty but ripe acidity with lovely minerality
- 18. Domaine de Varoux Chablis,** £29.70
Chardonnay at its best. Steely, light and clean. Green apples linger on the lasting finish
- 19. Puligny Montrchet Domaine Alain Chavy, France** £77.60
Fresh and clean with elegant touches of oak and a mineral backbone. A truly special white wine.

- 41. Sherwood Estate Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand** £17.10
Fresh and lively with gooseberry fruit aromas and passion fruit on the palate.
- 42. Domaine Menard Gaborit Muscadet, France** £14.90
Dry and crisp but with good depth of flavour and fruit. Excellent with all fish dishes.

Rosé Wines

- 20. Mercedes Cabernet Rosado, Spain** £19.80
Lusciously deep in colour with red berry aromas. It has balance, intensity and style.
- 21. Domaine des Claireneaux Sancerre, Loire France** £32.70
Made using pinot noir, this stylish wine is light with subtle raspberry flavours light salmon in colour and possess a fresh acidity giving a balanced finish, packed with aromatic fruit flavours.

Red Wines

- 23. Costa Vera Merlot, Chile** £16.30
Clean, crisp lemon notes with a dry zesty finish. A beautiful companion to seafood dishes.
- 24. Nostros Pinot Noir, Chile** £16.90
Light and fruity with delicate tannins and a lingering finish
- 25. Caldora Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Italy** £16.70
Fruity in style this wine has all the warmth you would expect from this Italian classic
- 26. Clastru's Douro Tinto, Portugal** £23.50
Full and spicy, this wine has bags of flavour and structure to match.
- 27. Mercedes Cabernet Sauvignon, Spain** £19.30
A firm grippy wine, intense and structured with powerful berries.
- 28. Scotto Lodi Zinfandel, California USA** £19.10
Classic zinfandel, spicy and hints of dark chocolate. A rich full flavoured wine with plum and cassis.
- 29. Medievo Crianza, Rioja Spain** £24.30
Deep garnet in colour, with blackberry fruits. Oak ageing imparts a subtle warmth.
- 30. Gougenheim Malbec, Argentina** £23.80
A rich supple wine with plum and chocolate aromas, An incredibly balanced wine with a delicious finish
- 31. Vacqueyras Ravoire, Rhone France** £22.70
Spicy and structured, this chunky wine from the Rhone is full of flavour and character.
- 32. Bremerton Shiraz, Australia** £27.60
Rich and jammy with intensity and body. Powerful yet incredibly balanced.
- 33. Hunters Pinot Noir, New Zealand** £29.80
Light and fruity, cherry notes fill the palate, with good body and harmony.
- 34. Chateau Chivrac 2006, Bordeaux France** £34.60
Produced by Cornishman. Mark Hellyar this is a big, fruity Claret with structure and body. Complex fruit layers and touches of vanilla on the nose.

- 43. Sherwood Estate Pinot Noir, New Zealand** £17.10
Ripe plum notes lead to complexity on the nose. Rich and rounded palate with fine fruit and light tannins.
- 44. Medievo Crianza, Rioja Spain** £17.90
Deep garnet in colour, with blackberry fruits. Oak ageing imparts a subtle warmth.
